What is a Greenhouse Church?

A greenhouse provides a healthy, protective, nutritional environment for plants to grow and thrive.



What is a Greenhouse Church?

A Greenhouse Church requires these components (assuming there are people in the church!)

- (1) A Spirit of Willingness to "give itself away"
- (2) A Leadership Development Pathway
- (3) Faith-Filled Risk to train and send leaders

10 Ways to Help a Church Plant

- 1. Pray for a planter and their team.
- 2. Send a planting couple to dinner.
- 3. Invite a planter to share their vision with your church.
- 4. Give a church plant a one-time gift.
- 5. Hold a "baby shower" for a church plant.
- 6. Loan your facility to a church plant.
- 7. Financially support a plant for a year or more.
- 8. Send people from your church to serve for a season.
- 9. Partner with other churches to plant a church.
- 10. Develop and deploy a planter & team from your church.
